BREEDING IN HAND CLASSES: IN THE RING CLASS ENTRANCE PROCEDURE will be used for all Breeding/in-Hand halter classes and all horses will be judged using the **ARABIAN SCORING SYSTEM**. **EXCEPTION:** Comparative judging will be used for Championship Breeding & in-Hand halter classes.

BREEDING/IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: Breeding/in-Hand show champions and reserves must be at least two years of age and are selected as outlined in USEF GR8 10.5. Arabian/Half-Arabian/ Anglo-Arabian yearling geldings may compete for Champion Gelding.

POST ENTRY DEADLINE: For horses already entered in the show, post entries will be accepted up to 1 hour prior to the class, except in Dressage. Post entries in dressage must be approved by the Dressage Manager, Annette Wells. New horses must be entered 4 hours prior to the class.

DOGS AND PETS: The state humane officer requires all dogs to be leashed AT ALL TIMES. This rule will be strictly enforced. Owner assumes all liability for pet animals.

FARRIER: A farrier will be available on the grounds during show hours.

FIRE REGULATIONS PROHIBIT PARKING BETWEEN THE BARN: As soon as you unload your horse, please move your vehicle to a designated parking area. Parking in the barn area is prohibited. Vehicles in "No Parking" areas will be towed at the owner's expense. Access to the barn area during the show hours will be limited. Specific areas have been set aside for parking horse trailers and vans for exhibitors showing from the trailer. Trailers may be moved by Brookside Management if not parked properly.

FIRST AID: There will be an EMT on the grounds during show hours.

FOOTING – There is sand footing in all arenas and warm-up rings. Ring dimensions are as follows: Main Arena – 275' x 150', Arena #2 – 240' x 150' and Grand Prix Arena – 150' x 240'. The warm-up arenas are 200' x 150'.

REFUNDS: To encourage early entries, the management agrees to cancel and refund entry and stall fees on any horse not fit to show providing written notice is given to the Show Secretary on or before September 27, 2017. Requests received between September 29 and October 1, 2017 show management will consider refunds due to illness, injury or accidents. All requests must be in writing, accompanied by a Veterinarian Certificate, and must be received by the Show Secretary prior to the start of the show. On approved refunds, all class fees will be refunded. Refunds for stalls, tack rooms or miscellaneous fees will be on a case by case basis. Any refunds will be made by mail, approximately one month after the show.

RV OVERNIGHT: Limited RV hook-ups (15AMP) are available on reservation only. RV spaces must be reserved. Any rig plugged into an electrical hook-up will be considered an RV. There is a flat fee of \$125 for the entire show. Very limited electrical power is available especially on very hot days. It has improved though. Please bring your own generator just in case it is needed. SHOW OFFICE AND REGISTRATION: Registration at the Horse Show Office by the exhibitor is required upon arrival at the show grounds. The show office will be open 1:00 PM on Wednesday, September 27 and daily one hour prior to the start of the first class each day of the show. The office will be closed for lunch and dinner. It will close after the last class of each day except Sunday when the office will stay open 1 hour after the last class.

STABLING ASSIGNMENTS: NO STALLS WILL BE RESERVED WITHOUT PRE-PAYMENT IN FULL – Assignment of stalls is entirely at the discretion of the Barn & Show Manager. Horses must be placed in stalls assigned and no changes will be permitted without the express consent of the Barn Manager. Assignments will be made as fairly as possible on the basis of the many considerations, including sponsorship support, number of horses, past participation in this show optimum use and convenience, show décor, time of receipt of entries, ring use, number of classes entered and access considerations. We ask your cooperation in these assignments and once assignments have been made, please do not deviate without specific approval of the Barn Manager. Patron sponsors will have 1st priority in stable assignments. Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together should submit their entries in the same envelope. Please indicate on the entry form (stable with line) any special requests. Management will try to stable late entries as closely as possible to other entries, but there are no guarantees. Show management's decision is final. **NOSHAVINGS PROVIDED.**

STABLING FACILITIES: LIMITED: Each animal must be assigned to a separate stall (exception: broodmares with suckling foals). Horses must be placed in the stalls assigned. No changes permitted without express consent of the Barn Manager. Stalls will be available Wednesday September 27, 2017 and must be vacated no later than Sunday evening October 1, 2017. Exhibitors arriving prior to, or departing later than, these specified times should contact the Show Manager and make special arrangements and will be required to pay an additional daily fee of \$10 per stall per day. Portable stalls (canvas) with double doors will be \$105.00. Exhibitors may show from their trailers. Trailer fee is \$25.00 per horse. Every horse entered in this show, (except nursing foals with their dams) must pay either a stall or trailer fee – **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Exhibitors requesting special stall arrangements for being handicapped or disabled must have the blue State Handicap Card. Card number must be listed with the stall request. Stall decorations **MUST** be made of non-flammable material or treated and maintained in a flame retardant condition. (Fire Marshall Sub-chapter 8) No nails, staples, screws etc. are allowed in stalls. No straw allowed. Only manure and shavings may be put in the manure piles or left in the stalls. Please put all trash in the trashcans. Any exhibitor found in violation of this rule will be charged accordingly for repair and repainting.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitution of a horse may not be made after the announced closing date of entries. If a horse is sold or injured after close of entries, exhibitor may post enter another in classes only.

STALLIONS: Stallions may be shown by ladies and junior exhibitors in any class except showmanship, walk/trot and lead line.

MEDAL CLASSES: Class specifications for Medal Classes are now in the USEF Rule Book.

TWO MINUTE GATE RULE: Due to a full schedule of classes, the two-minute limit for gates will be strictly enforced. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. The gate will close two minutes after the first horse has entered the ring or in the case of large classes taking more than two minutes, as the final horse in a continuous string of horses. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that his/her horse is at the gate on time. Class calls must be considered a courtesy only. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction.

VETERINARIAN: A veterinarian will be "ON CALL" only and NOT present during the show. All animals are subject to physical inspection by the Show Veterinarian at the discretion of the Show Committee.

CRUELTY: Cruelty to, or the abuse of, a horse by any person at a recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, show ring, or elsewhere on the show grounds before or during a show, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty. (See GR302)

ADMISSION TO THE RING: No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants of the class, judges and their assistants and show officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge.

AGE OF HORSES: For horse show purposes, any horse shall be considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling. A Junior Horse is one that is 5 years old and under.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA Membership/Competition Card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event Membership Fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA Single Event Membership. Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions. Exhibitors in Walk/trot classes are exempt from AHA Membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA Membership with competition card at AHA Regional and National Competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA Membership requirements. (BOD 5/12)

USEF MEMBERSHIP RULE Life, senior active and junior members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions. Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass (nonmember) fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline: 2) exhibitions: 3) games and races: 4) classes for 4-H members: 5) walk trot and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program): 6) USDF introductory level tests: 7) NRHA Reining Competitions: 8) Opportunity classes: 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION

1. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation. Certification will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur certification.
2. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. Any amateur who wishes to be re-classified on the grounds that he/she has engaged or is planning on engaging in activities which would prevent him/her from continuing to remain an amateur must notify the Federation in writing.

AMATEUR/OWNERS TO RIDE CLASSES: An Owner's Class is one in which every contestant is an Amateur and the rider, handler or driver is the Owner or an Amateur Member of the owner's family (See GR106). Combined ownership is not permitted in Amateur/Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. Leased horses are not eligible for amateur owner to ride classes.

CROSS ENTRIES: ARABIANS & HALF ARABIANS: Cross-entries are prohibited between Country English Pleasure section and the English Pleasure section and the English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving sections and/or Informal/Combination classes at the same show. Cross-entries are prohibited between the Pleasure Driving sections and the Country Pleasure Driving and Country Pleasure sections and/or Country Pleasure Combination classes at the same show.

DRUG & MEDICATION: All horses entered in the competition must be assessed a fee of \$16 (USEF) and \$5 (CDF) per horse to defray the expenses of the Drug testing. Horses in competition at a recognized competition are subject to examination by licensed veterinarian or appointed technician to perform certain duties under GR402.

EXHIBITOR IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS: Each horse entered in this show must be assigned an identification number for this show. Correct numbers must be worn by the riders and handlers in all classes.

HACKAMORES & SNAFFLES: Hackamore (Bosal) and standard snaffles (As defined in Rule XVI, Article 1678.3) are permitted on ALL horses five years and under in all Western classes. Two hands may be used on Hackamore (Bosal) and Western Snaffle reins.

HALF ARABIAN COLTS: Half-Arabian Colts/Stallions, two years & older are excluded from all halter classes.

HOOF RULE: See rule AR103 in the USEF Rulebook

INDEMNITY & NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES: All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Diablo Arabian Horse Association and the Brookside Show Park will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited, or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify Diablo Arabian Horse Association and the Brookside Show Park against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the revisions herein set forth.

INSURANCE ADVISORY: Due to the number and quality of horses at this show we urge each exhibitor to verify their liability insurance coverage and their livestock mortality coverage with their own insurance carrier(s). Be sure your coverage is in effect. The Diablo Arabian Horse Association, its members, agents, employees and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

JUDGES: If, for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize list. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS: To be eligible, Riders must not have reached their 19th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. Persons born on December 1st assume the greater age on that date.

SELECT RIDERS: Select Adult Amateurs: Has not received one of the following: a. Has not leveled out of the National Select Amateur Level, b. Has not received more than 75 AHA Achievement points

Select Junior Riders: Has not received one of the following: a. Has not leveled out of the National Select Youth Level, b. Has not received more than 100 AHA Achievement points

Select Open Riders: Has not received one of the following: a. Has not leveled out of the National Select Open Level, b. Has not received more than 100 AHA Achievement points

NOVICE & LIMIT HORSES/EXHIBITORS: A Novice horse or exhibitor is one, which has not won three 1st place ribbons. A Limit horse or exhibitor is one, who has not won more than 6 1st place ribbons at a Recognized Show of the USEF. In the Arabian Division, ribbons won within a section shall not count in reckoning maiden/novice/limit status if the animal or exhibitor is transferred to a new classification (e.g. Arabian Park to Arabian Western Pleasure, etc.) at a Regular Member Show of American Horse Shows Association or the Canadian Equestrian Federation. For purposes of this show, a maiden, novice or limit horse or exhibitor is as of the date of closing of entries.

Paddock/WARM UP ARENAS: There shall be no conduct in the paddock area, which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses or handlers/riders. There will be no whips, noisemakers or other equipment device or objects allowed in the paddock area, which may disturb or create a hazard to horses or handlers/riders. Exception: The show whip carried properly by a handler. Spectators are asked not to be in the paddock/warm-up arena area during the show.

PROTESTS: Should any question or dispute arise, it must be protested in the same manner prescribed by USEF Rule GR603. A protest may be received by the Steward, Show Secretary, Show Manager or by a member of the Show Committee within 48 hours of the alleged violation.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: The management reserves the rights to cancel any entries to any exhibitor, as stated in USEF GR1509.

RULES: The Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of USEF, the Prize List and the show based on rules of the current USEF Rule Book and the AHA Handbook: any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF and AHA Rules. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and Specification of the current USEF Rule Book and the AHA Handbook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Questions not covered by USEF and AHA Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and its decision will be final.

SCRATCHING CLASSES As a courtesy to the Gate Man, Announcer and Show Office, exhibitors are requested to notify the Gate and the Show Office when it is necessary to scratch a class entered. A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for non-notification of a scratched class. **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED IN 2017**

MOTORIZED VEHICLES– Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for the child committing the offense. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion for the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule

TBA CLASSES – Any class on the AHA Class List (located on the AHA website) can be offered as a TBA class. **EXCEPTIONS:** Working Hunter, Team Penning, Ranch Sorting, Dressage, Jumper, Eventing, Combined Driving, Carriage Driving, Cutting, Reined Cow Horse, Working Cow Horse or any existing Championship classes will be held during the TBA time slots as noted in the schedule. Contact the show secretary if you would like to add a class. TBA Classes will be limited to TWO classes per entry and will be assigned on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS. The sponsorship fees are \$15.00 for a regular class and \$25.00 for a championship class. The TBA class entry fees are \$24 entry fee for a regular class and \$32 entry for a championship class. The TBA sponsor pays a sponsorship fee on top of the class fee. Anyone else entering that class only pays the class entry fee. No post entry fees are charged for TBA classes.

VACCINATIONS: Horses coming to the Diablo Arabian Fall Fling Horse Show will be required to have Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months of the show date. Horses entering from outside the state will also need a health certificate in addition to the Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the show grounds.

Personnel will be on-site checking for paperwork. Owners and trainers will need a copy of the paperwork with them in the barn and a copy must be submitted to the show office prior to back numbers being released.

WESTERN DRESSAGE: The goal of Western Dressage is to develop a partnership between a happy equine athlete working in harmony with his rider. A system of progressive training produces a horse that is physically strong, balanced, supple and flexible; this equine athlete also demonstrates a calm, confident, attentive attitude and is happy to do his job.

The Western Dressage horse demonstrates free flowing, comfortable strides. The gaits are free, regular in cadence and rhythm, consistent in speed and tempo. The horse presents a balanced appearance.

The Western Dressage horse's head and neck are carried in a relaxed, natural manner; head and neck carriage are dictated by conformation and serve as a balance arm to facilitate proper movement.

The Western Dressage horse engages his hindquarters; uses his back freely; and lifts his forehead. These characteristics of framing and movement are more pronounced as the horse advances in his training and development.

Lightness and harmony are the hallmarks of the Western Dressage horse; he willingly accepts a light contact on the bit without tension or resistance. He gives the appearance of performing the requested gaits and maneuvers of his accord. The horse and rider appears as one.

Horses may compete in no more than one Licensed Competition on the same day and are not limited to a maximum number of rides. Horses may enter no more than two consecutive levels, Freestyle levels included, at any one competition.

When the entry is permitted to cross enter between Western Dressage and other classes of a competition, the requirements for warm up apply to when the exhibitor is actually warming up for their Dressage ride.

Supplemental hair and roached manes are not permitted. Manes are not required to be braided.

ATTIRE: See USEF Rule Book WD504.

TACK: See USEF Rule Book WD 501-503.

GAITS: The horse's three gaits, walk, jog and lope, will be enhanced and amplified through correct training. Development of his strength and balance as a result of correct training will now let him carry his rider with ease and confidence while maintaining correct rhythm and a steady tempo at all times.

ADDITIONAL MOVEMENTS & METHODS: See USEF Rule Book WD301- 306, WD401-404.

EXECUTION & JUDGING OF TESTS: See USEF Rule Book WD508-510.

TESTS: Tests are located on the USEF website at www.usef.org.

INTRODUCTORY LEVEL: Tests provide an introduction to the discipline of Western Dressage; the horse performs only at the gaits of walk and jog. The rider should demonstrate correct basic position, use of basic aids and understanding of figures. The horse should show relaxation; harmony of horse and rider are important. The jog should be a natural gait within the horse's scope and should demonstrate a swinging back.

BASIC: Tests confirm that the horse is supple and moves freely forward in a clear and steady rhythm, accepting light contact with the bit. The horse demonstrates a greater understanding of

the aids and calm acceptance of the bridle; greater emphasis is placed on relaxation submission, harmony, rideability and pure gaits. The horse is beginning to develop more power and balance.

LEVEL 1: Tests confirm that the horse is building on the elements from lower levels and has developed the impulsion to achieve improved balance while beginning to develop the self-carriage and engagement required by the "lengthen" jog and lope. The horse demonstrates a more consistent light contact with the bit. Tests introduce collection and engagement as well as lateral and longitudinal balance while emphasizing rideability.

LEVEL 2: To confirm that the horse, having achieved the impulsion required in Level 1, now accepts more weight on the hindquarters (collection); moves with an uphill tendency; especially in the lengthened paces; and is reliably and lightly on the bit. A greater degree of straightness, bending, suppleness, balance and self carriage is required than at Level 1.
